Memorial for Rapoport

A memorial service for the sculptor Nathan Rapoport will be held Sunday at 11 A.M. at the Park Avenue Synagogue, 50 West 87th Street. Mr. Rapoport, who was known for his monuments to the Holocaust, died June 4 at the age of 76.

Speakers at the service, which is open to the public, are to include Samuel Norich, executive director of the YIVO Institute for Jewish Research; Rabbi David Lincoln of the Park Avenue Synagogue; Benjamin Abileah, Israeli Consul General in Toronto, and Shlomo Ben Israel, a radio commentator and journalist.
